# LANDSCAPE WASTE PICK-UP

WHAT is considered yard waste? Yard waste consists of grass, leaves, tree limbs and/or brush. Limbs and brush must be in an approved container or cut and tied in bundles

no longer than 5-feet in length weighing no more than 50 lbs. Please use only non-plastic or non-metallic rope, twine or other binding string.

What SHOULDN'T go into a yard waste container? Do not mix yard waste with household waste or animal waste. Fruit and vegetable plants with produce attached to them should NOT be put in yard waste bins. (They are OK as yard waste if all produce is completely removed from the plant).
