This month, we'll be welcoming representatives of the CEO Council as our guests. They will present the costs and benefits associated with the City of Peoria potentially repurchasing the water works from Illinois American Water, something the City has the option of doing every five years under an 1899 franchise agreement. Also this month, the nomination committee will be presenting the slate for the May election of officers for the Uplands Residential Association. And we'll be voting on what we feel are the top three priorities on which the West Bluff Council (WBC) should focus.
