Acceptable yard waste materials are items such as grass, leaves, tree limbs and/or brush. Yard waste collection will resume on Thursday, April 5, 2018.

Have you all heard of the City's "Innovation Team" (www.peoriagov.org/innovation/)? It's a team of three people funded by a grant from Bloomberg Philanthropies that started a few years ago. The Innovation Team (or "i-team," for short) "sets out on a rigorous innovation process to suggest novel solutions to pressing problems." They're looking at the various commercial corridors in Peoria and "exploring what sort of initiatives can be launched to turn the tide in Peoria's neighborhoods by encouraging neighborhood scale economic development." They will be visiting us at a future URA meeting to discuss their efforts and get our feedback.

The URA does not meet in December due to holidays, vacations, etc., so our last neighborhood meeting of the year will be this Thursday, November 9, at 7 p.m. in the basement of the Bradley Epworth United Methodist Church. Doors open at 6:30. Hope to see you there!
